Thank you for your letters 15 and 21 of March to the Prime Minister concerning the media, and the tragic events at Dunblane. Broadcasting falls within the remit of this Department and I have been asked to reply. I apologise for the delay in doing so.

It may be helpful if I outline the regulatory framework governing broadcasting in this country. Under our broadcasting arrangements, responsibility for what is broadcast on television and radio rests with the broadcasters and the broadcasting regulatory bodies - the Governors of the BBC, the Independent Television Commission (ITC), S4C and the Radio Authority. They are independent of the Government and accountable for safeguarding the

Authority. They are independent of the Government and accountable for safeguarding the public interest in broadcasting. In carrying out their responsibilities, these authorities have a duty to ensure that programmes contain nothing which offends against good taste and decency or is likely to be offensive to public feeling. They also maintain guidelines for programme makers on the standards which should be observed. This guidance is wideranging: it includes advice on the timing of programmes and recommends when warning announcements about programmes should be made.

Within the framework outlined above, it is for the broadcasters to make judgement about the content of individual programmes and the time at which they are broadcast, in the light of the responsibilities placed upon them and of their more detailed programme guidelines. It is a long-standing principle that the government does not intervene in programme matters, either on arrangements for scheduling or on content.

Having said the above I have a but, my but is the fact that it is openly reported in the tabloids that it may well have been his late wife Mary Francis that might have been responsible for the contents in 'Come to Grief', for she was his researcher and draft copy editor for his books at the time.

Now I know my but is not an excuse for what Dick Francis did, and the fact is that his correspondence to me was signed by him and not his late wife.
